



Our New Look

We are SO excited to be back with you all at The Junction Church!! We want to make sure it is a safe and welcome environment for everyone, so with this in mind, we have changed our look a little bit...

- ❖ **Booking-In** – we have a NEW online booking system where you can reserve a seat in the service of your choice. On this form, you will be asked for a few details – these are so that you can be contacted in accordance to Track and Trace should there be a Covid-19 alert. Once you have booked in, you will receive a QR code, which you need to bring with you to church to officially sign in at the venue.
- ❖ **PPE** – All of our team will be wearing face masks/visors and where appropriate, aprons and gloves. We please ask that you wear a face mask, where possible, whilst inside our venues. Don't worry if you forget – we will have some spare available for you at the door! There will also be Hand Sanitizer stations around the venue.
- ❖ **Temperature Checks** - On arrival, we'll have team ready to conduct temperature checks on everyone who enters the venue. Please do respect this as it is purely for the safety of everyone who attends.
- ❖ **One-Way Systems** – As soon as you arrive at church, you will be met by our friendly team who will guide you through the new one-way systems that we have in place at our venues! This system means that we can ensure social distancing is maintained throughout our venues – so please help us out in this 😊
- ❖ **Registration** – Once inside our venues, you will be shown to our registration desk, where you can present your QR code and officially sign into the service. Here, you will receive your Service Wristband and can collect a Kids Pack, ask any questions you may have and take a look at our Seating Plan so you can get a good idea of where you are heading to find your seat.
- ❖ **Social Distancing** – We are working hard to make sure all our venues are conducive to social distancing, but we really need you to help us out with this. There will be clear signs and marking to facilitate moving around the venue and all seats will be spaced the appropriate distance apart from each other. Our team are there to help, but will remain a respectful distance at all times. Please bear with us on this – if all else fails, we may have to put our Charades skills to the test!!
- ❖ **Households and Bubbles** – If you have booked in with your household or bubble, you will be able to move your chairs closer together for the service. However, we do ask that you are careful in this, and if in doubt ask a member of our team to help you – that way we can ensure that everyone around is comfortable also.
- ❖ **Family Pods** – We have created a Family Pod Zone (in our Loughborough Campus only), which can facilitate families sitting together at a table during the service with a LIVE audio stream of the service. Each family pod seats up to 4 so feel free to book

more than one if necessary. As with the main auditorium chairs, these can be moved together if you should so wish.

- ❖ **Mums and Tots** – We have a ‘Mums and Tots’ room available on site for kids under the age of 5, if you and your little one should need a little extra room! Please note, you will still have to have booked into the service to be able to access this room – and it will be subject to capacity on the day.
- ❖ **Service Times** - Our services will last 30 minutes each (just for a season). This will include reflective worship and a short devotional talk. When the service finishes, we will be vacating the venue quite promptly, and we will guide this carefully. Do arrange to spend time with friends and family outside afterwards.
- ❖ **Communion** – We believe it is SO important to still take communion together – but we totally get that this is going to look very different in this season. As such, we have resourced some individual communion pods, which you will find on your seat (or your table if at a Family Pod). If you require a Gluten Free communion pod, please ask at registration and they will make sure you receive one 😊
- ❖ **Refreshments** – Unfortunately, under these new circumstances, we are unable to serve tea and coffee before or after our services, so make sure you get that caffeine fix beforehand! If you do bring any drinks or snacks with you, we ask you to please keep all rubbish with you and throw it away in the bins on the way out.
- ❖ **Toilets** – There will be access to toilets available on site, these are cleaned and sanitised regularly by our team throughout the day. Please note that due to social distancing measures, you may have to wait a little longer than normal – a member of our team will be around to ensure that you know where to wait and when you can enter the toilets.
